Waynesboro Players is pleased to offer the Lillian Morse Memorial Scholarship. Lillian Morse was a founding member of The Players who had particular interest in educating young people in the theatre arts and providing an opportunity for youth and all community members to give back to Waynesboro through the performing arts. The Players is the only fully volunteer community theatre organization in Waynesboro, with 57 years of history of bringing performance arts to life.

The Lillian Morse Scholarship Committee will consider applicants who show-

- An involvement in community and school theatre productions
- At least one Waynesboro Players production, on or off stage
- A commitment to academic excellence

Students should provide-

- A cover letter clearly denoting mailing address, email address, and other contact information. Letter should briefly outline the student's academic, extracurricular, and civic involvement. A resume of all activities may be included in addition to, but not in replacement of, the cover letter.
- An essay detailing what impact theatre has had on your life thus far, and future plans for theatre involvement.
- An official transcript of all courses taken.
- Two letters of reference. One from an individual who can speak to your academic performance, and one from an individual who can speak to your theatre contributions.

The committee has discretion in choosing scholarship recipients. Multiple or no scholarships could be awarded depending on the quality of the applications received. All materials must be received by the deadline date to be considered.
